In early 2003, Burn Stewart became part of CL WorldBrands Limited, the Trinidadian owned drinks group. Included in the CL WorldBrands structure are Angostura (rum and bitters) and Hine Cognac. The group also owns a number of in-market distribution companies.

DEANSTON

Deanston Distillery, near Doune, Perthshire, rests on the banks of the River Teith. This historic building, which dates back to 1785 was originally a cotton mill.

The mill was converted to a full working distillery in 1966, making use of the crystal clear waters of the River Teith for the distillation of its single malt whisky and of the listed cellar buildings which provide the perfect storage conditions for maturing the whisky. Water powered turbines are the energy source, with two pairs of large bulbous pot stills capable of distilling three million litres of alcohol a year. The enclosed riverside warehouses give excellent conditions of constant humidity and temperature for ageing malt whisky.

Bunnahabhain

Bunnahabhain Distillery (pronounced $B\bar{u}$ -na-ha-venn) lies on the isolated north-eastern tip of the Hebridean Isle of Islay.

The distillery, built in 1881, lies close to the Margadale River (Bunnahabhain means "mouth of the river" from the Scots Gaelic tongue). Today, the Bunnahabhain Distillery maintains the traditional production methods of the 1800's. Bunnahabhain is quite distinct from the other single malts of the Island, given the wonderfully gentle taste profile for which it is known.

The Tobermory Distillery is the only distillery on the picturesque Hebridean Isle of Mull and is one of the oldest operational mult Scotch whisky distilleries. Tobermory celebrated its 200th anniversary in 1998.

The name Tobermory is derived from the Gaelic "Tobar Mhoire", which means "Well of Mary" and relates to the well and chapel of St Mary. The original name for the distillery - Ledaig (pronounced Led-chig) is also Gaelic and means "safe haven".

Ledaig 10 year old Single Malt Scotch Whisky

Tobermory's peated big brother also comes from the delightful Tobermory Distillery and has become synonymous with the peated style of single malt from the island. The fascinating name "Ledaig" pronounced "Led-chig" translates from the Gaelic tongue to "Safe Haven", aptly named after the area on which the distillery sits, neatly sheltered in Tobermory Bay.
